ONE TO ONE OR GROUP MENTORING

- Peer mentoring program for Albertans dealing with challenges of hearing loss
- Develop meaningful connections to decrease social isolation
- Volunteers share lessons from their own journey.
- In-person or virtual

HARD OF HEARING MEET UPS

- Monthly social meetings for connections and learning



TECHNOLOGY

- Screened and trained volunteers coach and support seniors to use iPads, computers, and smart phones
- Helps alleviate fear of learning new skills
- Meet in homes, restaurants, libraries and parks, & seniors residences

Room Rentals



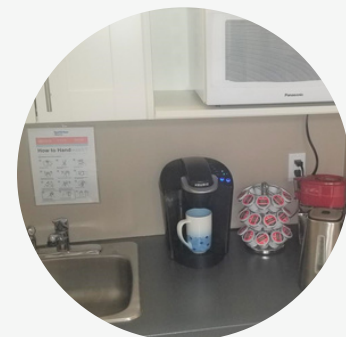
COMMUNITY ROOM

- 90 person capacity
- Projector, screens
- Warming kitchen



BOARD ROOM

- 12 person capacity
- Projector, screen



RENTAL COSTS

- \$65 per hour, minimum 2 hours
- \$50 clean-up fee may also apply
- Portable outdoor canopies are available for \$125 per day
- It is renter's responsibility to obtain required liquor permits and submit these to DHA prior to the rental date
- Plenty of free parking available
- Wheelchair accessible with ramp and elevator

American Sign Language Instruction



SIGNING NATURALLY

- Online & in-person classes
- Subsidy available for Calgarians who qualify
- \$390 per course plus textbook if needed



CUSTOMIZED ASL

- Can be arranged for any group size
- Qualified Deaf instructor
- Ideal for workplaces
- Deaf cultural training can be included
- Private 1-on-1 instruction: \$60 per hour
- Group instruction (up to 12): \$160 per hour



ASL SUMMER CAMP

- weekly classes in July & August
- Recommended age 14 and up
- \$250 per session

IN-PERSON INTERPRETERS

- Must be pre-booked
- Nonprofit rate available



VIRTUAL REMOTE (VRI) INTERPRETERS

- Pre-booked
- Nonprofit rate available
- Can join virtual meeting platforms like Zoom



VRI ON DEMAND

- \$150 annual subscription plus \$2.80 per minute
- Available 24/7 to subscribers

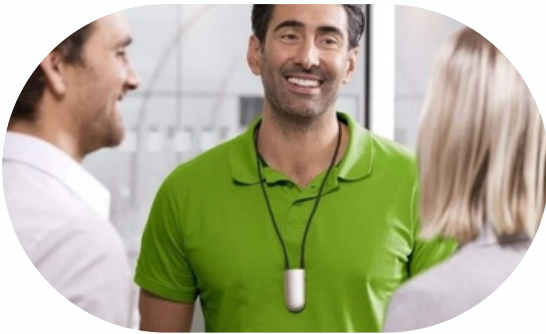

Deaf & Hear Alberta Workplace/Facility Assessments

STEP 1: ONSITE CONSULTATION



- Onsite DHA consultant and employee conversation & assessment of physical surroundings
- Consultant develops an understanding of the communication barriers at play.
- May involve testing assistive devices

STEP 2: FOLLOW-UP REPORT



- Consultant compiles information and makes recommendations in a written Accommodation Plan
- Consultant submits Accommodation Plan to employer/business owner

COST:

- \$500 for corporate assessment
- \$450 for registered non-profit organizations
- Additional costs such as parking, transportation are extra



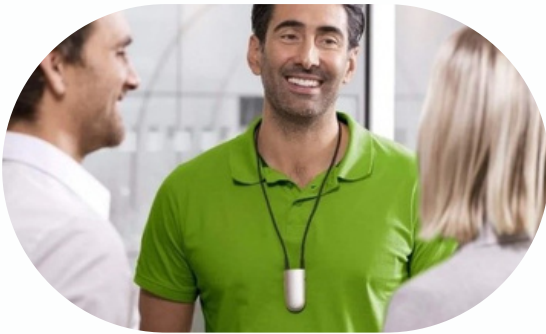
